# This Week Highlights



**PPKM is extended until October 18, 2021** by remaining at level 3 with relaxation, such as fitness center (gym) opening trial with capacity 25% and strict health protocols implementation.



**The odd-even traffic policy in Jakarta has been reinstated since Monday, October 18, 2021**, which is valid at 06:00-10:00 and 16:00-20:00 on Monday-Friday.



**As of October 16, 2021, it is recorded that 10.745.792 residents have been injected with dose 1 vaccine in DKI Jakarta**; 65% of them are residents with Jakarta ID card and 35% with non-Jakarta ID card. **While as many as 8.115.395 residents in DKI Jakarta have been injected with dose 2 vaccine**; 67% of them are residents with Jakarta ID card and 33% with non-Jakarta ID card. **Especially for residents with Jakarta ID card, 78% residents have been injected with dose 1 vaccine and 60% have been injected with dose 2 vaccine.**



**Daily isolation bed occupancy rate reaches 7% and ICU bed occupancy rate reaches 16%.**



**Recovery rate in this week increased from 98,23% to 98,27%.**



**Positivity rate in this week is still the same as last week, remaining at 0,8%.**

In this week, positive cases has increased by 43 cases to 993 cases compared to last week that reached 950 cases. While recovery rate in this week has increased by 319 cases to 1.299 cases from 980 cases last week. Increase in positive cases should be an alarm for the community to keep implementing strict health protocols and reduce mobility, especially if there is no urgent need.

Until today, Jakarta is still remaining at PPKM Level 3 with easing of activities. People shouldn't be careless with development of cases and relaxations in activities, all elements should always be consistent in implementing 6M and 3T in order to suppress Covid-19 transmission. Jakarta residents who haven't been vaccinated are expected to get vaccinated immediately in the nearest vaccination centers. Vaccination is one way to suppress the emergence of positive cases and to prevent residents from experiencing severe symptoms of Covid-19.

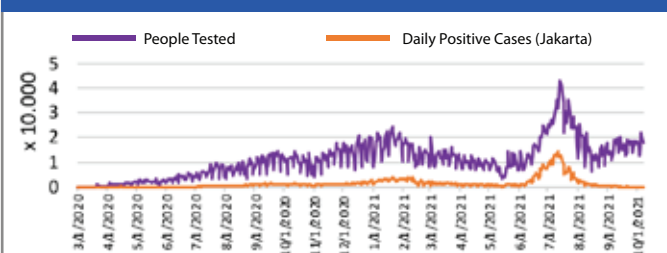

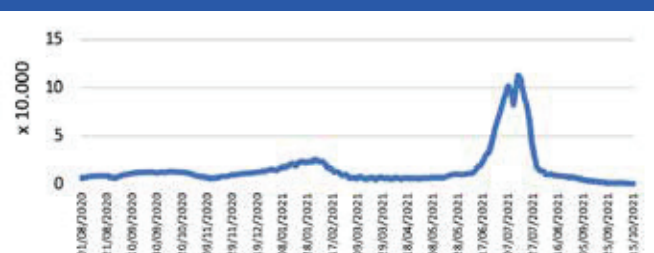

## Daily Positive Cases and Daily Tests



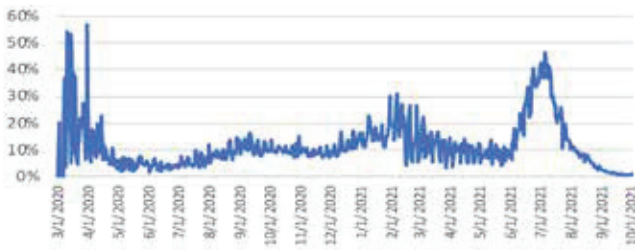
- As of **October 9, 2021**, daily positive cases **increased by 30 cases into 154 cases**
- Total positive cases in the past week reached **993 people**.

## Development of Active Cases in Jakarta



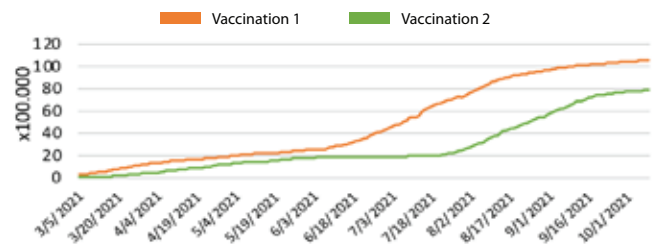
**Until October 16, 2021, total active case in Jakarta reached 1.342 (0,2% positive cases) and recorded as the lowest active case since August 2020.**

## Daily Positivity Rate



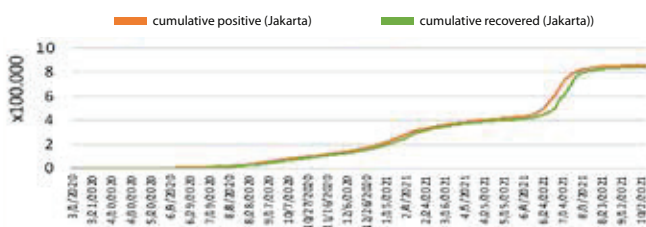
- Positivity rate is ratio between number of positive cases and number of tests performed.
- Total **6.576.804 people** had been tested using PCR and **860.014** people confirmed positive for Covid-19, thus positivity rate in Jakarta reached **13,1%**.
- Positivity rate in this week is the same as last week, which is still at **0,8%**.

## Accumulation of Vaccination Progress in Jakarta



- Until **October 16, 2021**, as many as **10.745.792** people had been injected with dose 1 vaccine in Jakarta.
- Total **8.115.395 people** had been injected with dose 2 vaccine or fully vaccinated.

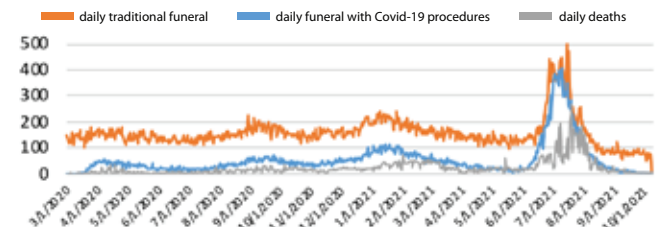
## Recovered Cases and Positive Cases



- Recovery rate is measured from accumulated recovered cases which is divided by accumulated positive cases.
- As of **October 16**, as many as **845.121 people** have recovered from Covid-19
- Number of people who have recovered from Covid-19 in this week reached **1.299 people**.
- Recovery rate in this week has increased from **98.23% to 98.27%**
- It can be seen on the chart that cumulative positive case is starting to decline.

## Death Cases

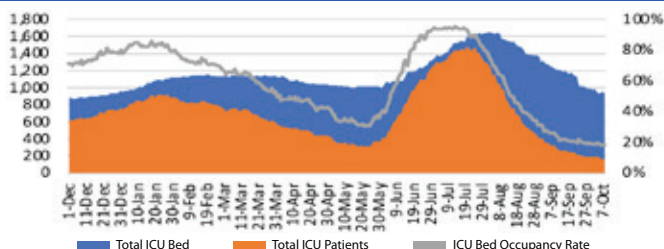
(funeral with Covid-19 procedures and traditional funeral)



- Until **October 16, 2021**, total death cases reached **13.551 cases (1,6% positive cases)**.
- Average death cases in the past week reached **1 cases per day**.
- Until October 16, 2021, there were **31.878 cases** for funerals reported with Covid-19 procedures and **93.559 cases for traditional funerals**.
- The highest case for funeral with Covid-19 procedures was recorded on July 10, 2021 with total **404 cases**. The lowest number of funerals with Covid-19 protocols was reported on **October 7, 2021 with 0 cases**.

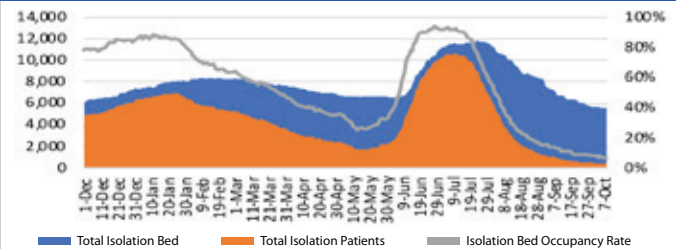
Disclaimer: Funerals with Covid-19 procedures also include suspected cases of Covid-19 who have not received PCR results, so the number may differ from total Covid-19 deaths.

## Daily ICU Bed Occupancy Rate



- ICU bed occupancy rate in Jakarta per **October 16, 2021** reached **16%**, it declined by **2%** from last week (**October 9**) and it was the lowest since **December 2020**.
- The highest number of ICU patients reached **1.484 people** on July 21.
- After its peak that reached **95%** on July 10 and 11, 2021, daily ICU bed occupancy rate in DKI Jakarta continued to decline.

## Daily Isolation Bed Occupancy Rate



- Daily isolation bed occupancy rate in Jakarta per **October 16, 2021** reached **7%**, which is the same as last week (**October 9**) and it was the lowest since **December 2020**.
- The highest total isolation patients recorded on July 11 with total **10.623 people** with bed occupancy rate **92%**.
- The highest isolation bed occupancy rate during emergency PPKM recorded on July 5 and 6, 2021 that reached **93%**.
- Bed occupancy rate started to decline in the middle of Emergency PPKM until today.

# COVID-19 VACCINATION IN JAKARTA

The higher Covid-19 transmission rate means vaccination is absolutely necessary. Vaccine can protect us by creating antibody or immune system. With antibody, our body has been trained to prevent from being exposed to Covid-19. Vaccination cannot cure Covid-19 completely. But, according to experts, although infected by Covid-19 after being vaccinated, the vaccine will protect the body from severe and deadly symptoms. **It can also become a weapon to fight the pandemic by building herd immunity or population immunity if more than 70% population have been vaccinated.** Get vaccinated immediately at the nearest vaccination site!

## How to Get Vaccines in Jakarta

### Requirements for Vaccination

- Bring original **ID card (KTP)** to the vaccination site.
- Bring copy of **family card (KK)** for those who don't have KTP.
- Vaccination receivers who register via JAKI or [corona.jakarta.go.id](https://corona.jakarta.go.id) website should **show their printed pre-screening results** as a proof of registration.

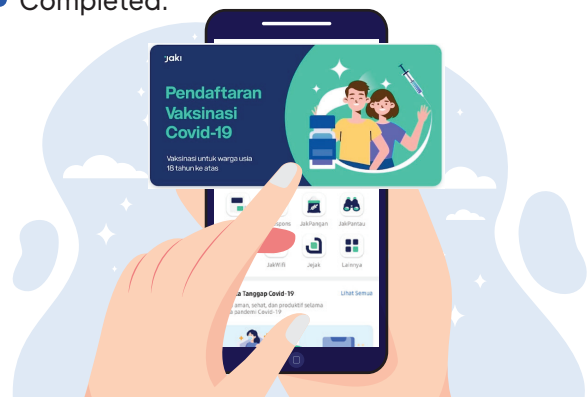

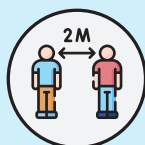

# Is Covid-19 Vaccine Safe for People with GERD?



Not everyone can receive Covid-19 vaccine even though it has an important role in protecting body from Covid-19 infection. There are several groups of people who cannot receive Covid-19 vaccine, such as people with chronic gastrointestinal disorders. For further information, please read the points below.



Covid-19 vaccination **cannot** be given to people with chronic gastrointestinal disorders, such as:

- **Celiac disease**
- **Ulcerative colitis**
- **Chron's disease**

People with gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) are allowed to receive vaccination against Covid-19.



People with GERD **MUST** postpone Covid-19 vaccination if they experience:

- Severe stomach pain
- Chronic diarrhea (more than 14 days)
- There is change in bowel movement
- Significant weight loss
- Fever above 37.5°C



Vaccination is allowed as long as the patients don't have history of allergies to Covid-19 vaccine or components in Covid-19 vaccine

Decision whether they can get Covid-19 vaccination or not will be decided by doctor in charge of health screening section

# Understanding to Prevent Transmission of Covid-19 in Newborns



Covid-19 transmission can happen to anyone, including newborns. Hence, having a baby during a pandemic needs stricter attention and care from parents. The following is information about ways to prevent the transmission of Covid-19 in newborns.

## Prevent Transmission of Covid-19 in Newborns!

- 1** Wear a **medical mask inside** and a **cloth mask outside** when touching, holding, or when breastfeeding your baby
- 2** Always **wash your hands with soap and running water** before and after touching the baby and before breastfeeding
- 3** Keep baby away from sick people
- 4** Avoid the habit of **kissing and touching** the baby's face
- 5** Give breast milk until the baby is 6 months old **by following the health protocols**
- 6** If the mother/caregiver and baby have different Covid-19 status, **must keep a distance of 2 meters**, except when breastfeeding or giving expressed breast milk or when caring for a baby
- 7** If the baby and family members suffer from Covid-19 at the same time, **they can be isolated together**

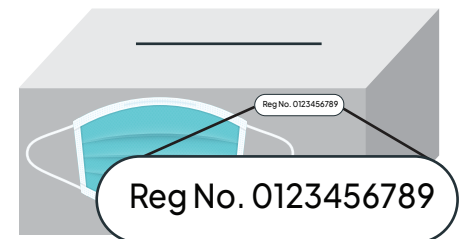
## TIPS FOR CHOOSING REAL AND SAFE MEDICAL MASKS

Be careful buying medical masks in the market, because many fake medical masks are circulating that closely resemble real masks and are sold at competitive prices. So, how to tell the difference between real and fake masks? Check out the following information!

### DIFFERENCE BETWEEN REAL AND FAKE MASKS

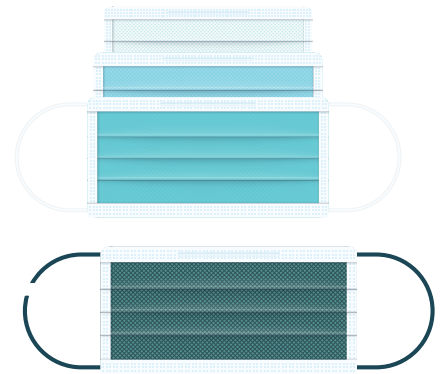
#### OFFICIAL DISTRIBUTION PERMIT

- Real masks have a distribution permit number from the Ministry of Health
- Fake masks do not have a distribution permit number from the Ministry of Health, but are claimed to be medical masks



#### MASK TEXTURE

- Real masks are made of spunbond non-woven material, meltblown, spunbond (SMS), as well as spunbond, meltblown, meltblown, spunbond (SMMS) with three layers
- Fake masks are usually more opaque and mask straps are more
- Easy to break



#### TEST WITH WATER

- Real mask is waterproof
- Fake masks are not waterproof

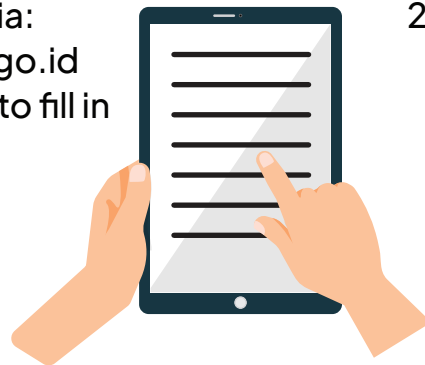


## NEWEST WAY TO GET QR CODE WITH PEDULILINDUNG FOR COMPANIES AND PUBLIC AREA CARETAKERS

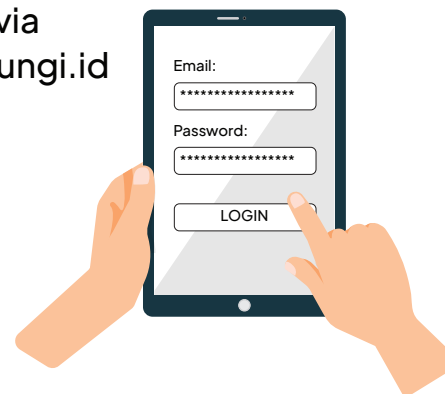

### 30 ODGJs Receive Covid-19 Shot at Ciracas Sub-district Puskesmas

As many as 30 people with mental disorders (ODGJ), received Covid-19 vaccine shots at the Ciracas Sub-district Puskesmas, East Jakarta, Tuesday (10/12). It was conducted to commemorate World Mental Health Day 2021.

Based on Beritajakarta.id, they were vaccinated in the mental health service room on the second floor of the puskesmas. They came with accompanying staff or accompanied by the family. After being vaccinated, they received parcels containing proper clothing, tumblers, bottled fresh drinks and snacks.

Ciracas Sub-district Puskesmas Head, Santayana Daulay said, they are patients who routinely seek treatment at the puskesmas. Aside that, the companions also got vaccinated.

“Then the type of vaccine used is Pfizer for the first shot, while the second dose adjusts to the type of the first shot,” he expressed.

Even, health workers were prepared to persuade, entertain and motivate them to get vaccinated.

“For those who have not been vaccinated or are still at home, we will coordinate with the local urban village or sub-district regarding vaccination services with jemput bola system,” he furthered.

Ciracas Sub-district Head, Mamad gave his appreciation to the puskesmas about the service. It really helped accelerate the achievement of vaccinations and for the sake of realizing herd immunity. Thus far, its achievement has reached 79 percent and has entered the yellow zone.

“Hopefully we can touch the green zone. That’s why we continue to intensify vaccination services,” he closed.

### Vaccination for Foreign Refugees and Asylum Seekers

Jakarta administration is cooperating with Jakarta Branch of Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Kadin) Agency and United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), to launch Covid-19 vaccinations for foreign refugees and asylum seekers domiciled in Greater Jakarta.

This stage 1 vaccination provides 600 acceptors or 1,200 vaccines (stages 1 and 2) with Sinopharm vaccine. In Jakarta, it is held at the Bulungan Sports Building, South Jakarta.

Jakarta Governor, Anies Baswedan who visited the vaccination center emphasized that the current pandemic is a humanitarian problem across nations and territories.

"The virus is contagious to anyone, both Indonesian citizens and foreigners, including asylum seekers. This is a human problem where all must receive the same treatment, despite our main priority is Indonesian citizens. But if there are some foreign refugees who are not vaccinated yet, the impact will also be on us," he explained.

He also explained the flow of collaboration between the administration with Kadin Agency and UNHCR related to vaccinations for foreign refugees and asylum seekers. To realize it, last July, he wrote to the Minister of Health, where the letter was answered with full support from Kadin and UNHCR.

"By so, Kadin is ready to help us through a private vaccination scheme as a form of gotong royong (mutual cooperation). Then us, we'll prepare regulations and vaccines. There is also the private SpeedLab which provides health workers and UNHCR which mobilizes data on foreign refugees and asylum seekers," he explained.

"This is an extraordinary job, this is a complicated job, surely we appreciate all parties involved. This is a humanitarian task. Thus, we won't be protected if not every one of us is protected. And Jakartans should be grateful as we can protect and help our brothers from different nations regarding this vaccination," he stated.

UNHCR noted that there were around 4,942 foreign refugees and asylum seekers aged 12 and over living in Greater Jakarta, but they had difficulty getting Covid-19 vaccine due to limited access and information, and the absence of a citizenship identification number (NIK) as the main prerequisite.

"With collaboration, approximately 600 foreign refugees and asylum seekers will get facilities to receive first shot. To make sure everyone gets vaccinated, we will do follow-up vaccinations," explained Jakarta Kadin Head, Diana Dewi.
